NORWAY- Glenn Roger Peterson age 81 of Norway, passed away surrounded by his family, Monday, November 22, 2021 at Dickinson Co. Memorial Hospital.

He was born January 4, 1940 in Norway, the son of the late Lawrence “Happy” and Theresa (Cologna) Peterson.

Hunting season was always the family vacation. Glenn loved hunting and he was the first one sitting in his blind in the morning. He also enjoyed fishing and trapping. Glenn believed in planting trees every year and planted hundreds over his lifetime.

Glenn is survived by his wife of 56 years Patricia; sons Roger (Rhonda) Peterson and Andrew Peterson; grandsons Angelo and Julio Peterson; brother Bertil (Donna) Peterson; nephews Chris (Cindy) Peterson, Michael Hynds, Dan (Melissa) Hynds, Robert (Michelle) Bonner and Ron (Jacki) Bonner; a niece Monica Hynds; brother-in-law Robert (Mary) Bonner; sister-in-law Barbara (Phil) Keen; several great nieces and nephews; and his beloved dog, Jewel.
