AUNE “Mickey” LAMBERT NORWAY- Aune “Mickey” Lambert age 84 of Norway died Tuesday, April 24, 2007 at her home. She was born on August 9, 1922 in Marquette, the daughter of the late John and Angelina (Heinonen) Michelson. Mickey graduated from Graverette High School in Marquette in 1940, she then attended Northern Michigan Teachers College. She moved to Chicago and worked at the aircraft manufacturing plant during World War II, moved back to Marquette and worked for Dow Chemical making char coal, and worked for the Marquette Mining Journal.
