BEN A. CASARI NORWAY- Ben Allen Casari age 67 of Norway, died Monday, October 11, 2010 at Aurora Bay Care in Green Bay, WI. He was born on October 13, 1942 in Norway, the son of the late Ben and Mary Ann (Karpenski) Casari. Ben graduated from Vulcan High School in 1960. He worked at the Norway Canning Factory for several years. Ben served his country in the U.S. Army as a communications specialist from 1963-1966, and continued in the Army Reserves at Ft.
