



## Charles Louis Pellegrini

April 9, 1935 - November 28, 2016

NORWAY- Charles "Charlie" L. Pellegrini, 81, of Norway, passed away, surrounded by family on Monday, November 28, 2016 at Dickinson County Healthcare System in Iron Mountain.

He was born on April 9, 1935 in Norway, son of the late Louis and Esther (Cologna) Pellegrini.

Charlie married Terese Neveau, of Niagara, on June 23, 1962 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Norway.

He grew up on the family farm in Norway and developed a strong work ethic, and graduated from Vulcan High School in 1953.

Charlie served his country and enlisted in the United States Air Force in 1954 and served in the Strategic Air Command. He was honorably discharged in 1958 and recently had the privilege of going on the UP Honor Flight to Washington, D.C. with his son Chuck.

He was employed at the Niagara Paper Mill for 40 years. He also drove school bus for his father and his brother Roger for many years. During his retirement he could be found helping his brother Roger at the Pellegrini farm in Vulcan.

Charlie enjoyed reading, walking his dogs, was an avid cross-country skier and a big fan of the Green Bay Packers. He spent many hours in his garden and enjoyed sharing produce with his friends and family. Charlie was always meticulous in the care of his vehicles, especially his Ford truck "Big Red", and spent time each week going to breakfast with his buddies.

Family was very important to him; he especially loved spending time with his grandkids. He was very proud of his children's and grandchildren's accomplishments.
