NORWAY- Charlotte Ann Vachon age 80 of Norway died Thursday, January 23, 2020 at ManorCare Nursing in Kingsford, MI.

She was born on October 15, 1939 in Norway, the daughter of the late Harold and Amelia (Zanon) Hallgren.

Following graduation from Norway High School in 1957, she moved to Milwaukee and attended Marquette University, graduating as a dental assistant. Char worked in the dental field until her retirement.
