NORWAY- Clayton Emory Lounds age 82 of Norway, died Tuesday, July 8, 2014 at Pinecrest Medical Care Facility in Powers, MI.

He was born August 8, 1931 in Sault Ste. Marie, MI the son of the late William and Eva (Longhurst) Lounds.

Clayton graduated from Sault Ste. Marie High School in 1950.
