Green Bay, Wis – Curtis D. Oberthaler, 90, of Norway, passed away peacefully at Grancare Nursing Center in Green Bay on Friday, Jan 3rd, 2020 where he had resided since 2018.

He was born November 28, 1929 in Norway, MI, son of the late Gerino and Alvina (Wegher) Oberthaler.

After graduating from Norway High School and serving his country in the US Navy on the USS Valley Forge, he married the love of his life Joan (Waltz) Oberthaler on May 23, 1953 in Milwaukee, WI.
