



## Darold Cayemberg

January 2, 1931 - August 9, 2023

VULCAN- Darold Arlen Cayemberg age 92 of Vulcan, died Wednesday, August 9, 2023 at Pinecrest Medical Care Facility in Powers, MI.

He was born January 2, 1931, in Red River, WI, the son of the late Patrick and Laura (Laurent) Cayemberg.

He graduated from Luxemburg High School in 1949 and was drafted into the Marines in 1951. He was a diesel mechanic during his time in the service. While in service he was married to the late Patricia (Vandenhouten) Cayemberg on October 8, 1952. After celebrating their 25th wedding anniversary, she preceded him in death on October 18, 1977.

After his military service, he moved back to Sugar Bush, WI where he farmed and started Cayemberg's Diesel Truck Service in Green Bay, WI with his brother Wayne Cayemberg.

In 1965, they moved to Norway, MI, where he was a well-known diesel mechanic for Smeesters Bros for many years. In 1977, he opened his own diesel mechanic business with Frank DuBord called Darold and Frankie's Place until retirement. His remaining years were spent farming at Red Valley Farm.

It seemed only fitting that Darold, a true American farmer and marine be laid to rest during harvest season. You could find him during the summer running his John Deere tractors and working his draft horses. Great memories were made on Red Valley Farm with his family.

He is survived by his children Roxane Melchiori, Rodney (Jeanne) Cayemberg, Scott (Jan) Cayemberg, Dawn (Joe) Pickart; grandchildren, Andrea (Mark), Matthew (Karen), Paul (Jeni), Ross (Kalee), Tricia (Andrew), Luke, Benjamin, Mitchell (Nikki), MyKaela, and Krystal; brother Roland Cayemberg (Ellen); sisters-in-law Delores Cayemberg, Marge Konkell, Sally Cayemberg and Laverne Vandenhouten; brother-in-law Ronald (Catherine) Vandenhouten; many extended friends and family. He had a special place in his heart for his 12 great grandchildren and loved spending time with his boys.
