VULCAN- Dolores Molia Butler age 93 of Vulcan, passed away Thursday, December 2, 2021 at Dickinson Co. Memorial Hospital in Iron Mountain, MI.

She was born on April 3, 1928 in Norway, the daughter of the late Louis and Minnie (Stevens) Tomasini.

Dolores graduated from Norway High School in 1945. Following graduation Dolores attended the Business Institute of Milwaukee and thereafter started her career working for the government.
