DOROTHY BRESIN IRON MOUNTAIN- Dorothy S. Bresin age 91 of Iron Mountain died Thursday, June 7, 2007 at Hyland Nursing Home in Iron Mountain, Michigan. She was born on May 18, 1916 in Iron Mountain, the daughter of the late Irving W. and Gertrude (Mason) Smith. Dorothy graduated salutatorian of her class from Niagara High School in 1933, and attended the University of Wisconsin at Madison. She married Louis H. Bresin on July 4, 1945. They moved to Crestline, Ohio in 1959 and lived there until 2001 when they moved back to Iron Mountain, Michigan. Louis preceded her in death on July 9, 2005. In Crestline, Dorothy was a member of the First United Methodist Church; she worked as the Society Editor for the Crestline Advocate newspaper for 23 years. She was a member of the Deborah Circle, very active member of the Order of Eastern Star and Secretary to the Administrative Board of the Church. She was a Board Member of the Crestline Library, a Red Cross Gray Lady at the Crestline Memorial Hospital as well as a Hospital Board Member for seven years. Dorothy is survived by her brother and sister-in-law Irving and Midge Smith; sister in-law Mary Bresin; brother in-law Alexander Bresin; and nieces and nephews. Her brother Mason Smith preceded her in death in 2000. A Graveside Service will be held at the Norway Township Cemetery at a later date.
