NORWAY – Dorothy “Dot” Mott, age 88, of Norway, died Sunday, August 23, 2020, at the home of her son in Mt. Clemens, MI.

She was born on October 28, 1931, in Norway, the daughter of the late Arthur Peterson and Myrtle (Lacrosse) Allard.

She graduated from Norway High School in 1949.
