FRED LUNDAMO NORWAY- Fred H. Lundamo age 87 of Norway died Sunday, February 1, 2009 at Manor Care West in Green Bay, Wisconsin. He was born on October 19, 1921 in Norway, the son of the late Harold and Theresa (Haglund) Lundamo. Fred graduated from Norway High School in 1940. He served his country in the U.S. Army during World War II. Fred married Gertrude Warmuth on July 18, 1942 at the Evangelical Covenant Church in Norway. She preceded him in death on December 4, 1999. He worked at the Niagara Paper Mill for 36 years, retiring in 1984. Fred was a member of the Evangelical Covenant Church in Norway, life time member of the Norvulet Post #4581, Veterans of Foreign Wars and the Norway-Vulcan Senior Center. He was an avid fisherman; he won the Salmon Derby in Ketchikan, Alaska in 1979. He enjoyed his traveling to Alaska for over 35 years. Fred is survived by his sons Ron (Judy) Lundamo of Ketchikan, AK and Duane Lundamo of Norway; grandchildren Rhonda (Kristian) Pickrell of Norfolk, VA and Mark (Merdith) Lundamo of Ketchikan, AK; great grandchildren Eleanor, Oscar, Madisen, Carter; sister Elvira Lundamo of Norway; brothers-in-law Fred Warmuth and Vernon Sauld; sister-in-law Pauline Holl; several nieces and nephews.
