GLENN R. PETERS WAUCEDAH TWP.- Glenn R. Peters age 66 of Waucedah Twp, died Friday, August 6, 2010 at the Oscar G. Johnson V.A. Medical Center in Iron Mountain, MI. He was born on January 31, 1944 in Hermansville, the son of the late Frank and Astrid (Peterson) Peters. Glenn graduated from Hermansville High School in 1962. He married Hazel Cowden on June 28, 1965 at Amarillo Air Force Base in Amarillo, Texas. Glenn served his country in the U.S. Air Force during the Vietnam War. They moved back to Hermansville in 1969, built a home in Waucedah Township in 1976. Glenn was a field mechanic working for Superior Equipment, Road Machinery and retired from MJ Electric in 2007. He was a member of the Floriano-Stecker Post #340, American Legion in Hermansville. Glenn enjoyed spending time with his granddaughter and his family, golfing, gardening, and wildlife. Glenn was able to fix or do anything he set his mind to. He is survived by his wife Hazel; son Glenn Peters, Jr. of Amarillo, TX; daughter Jenny (Andrew) Korpi of Marquette; granddaughter Andrea Korpi of Marquette; sister Carol (Wallin) Swanson of TN; many nieces, nephews and cousins. Glenn was preceded in death by his brothers Frank "Sonny" Peters, Jr. and Raymond Peters; and his twin sisters Jane and Joan Peters.
