IDA CUCCIATTI NORWAY- Ida L. Cucciatti age 89 of Norway, died Wednesday, October 28, 2009 at Manor Care Health Services in Kingsford, MI. She was born in Champion on January 7, 1920, the daughter of the late Charles and Aliina (Tauriainen) Maki. Ida married John Cucciatti on October 23, 1943 in Ishpeming. He preceded her in death on December 1, 1987. Ida was a hotel worker before her marriage and mainly a homemaker while her daughters were growing up. She later worked as a janitor for the Norway-Vulcan School System for several years. She was a faithful member of St. Mary's Church in Norway for the 55 years she lived in Norway, Legion of Mary, St. Mary's Altar Society, Blue Army Ministers of Praise and the Norway-Vulcan Senior Center. Ida returned to a great joy of her youth, dancing, after her husband died and became a faithful helper on pasty days at the Norway-Vulcan Senior Center. The Senior Center was an important part of her later years. She was known as a kind, generous person who always thought of others before herself. Ida is survived by her daughters Carla (Julius) Overbeck of Winchester, VA. and Maxine (Dave) Nobbe of Oshkosh, WI.; 3 grandchildren Catherine (Roger) Briggs of Hesston, PA, Carolyn (Marc) Flitcroft of Berryville, VA, and Christopher Nobbe of Oshkosh, WI; two great grandchildren Benjamin and Levi Briggs of Hesston, PA; brother Charles Maki of Norway; numerous nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by sisters Helen Anderson, Elsie Rytkenon and Viola Morgan. Visitation will be held on Monday, November 2 from 10-11 a.m. at St. Mary's Church in Norway.

The Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated on Monday at 11 a.m. at St. Mary's Church with Fr. James Roetzer, presiding. Interment will follow at the Norway Township Cemetery.
