JOAN TREIBER NORWAY- Joan R. Treiber age 86 of Norway, died Tuesday, February 15, 2005 at Dickinson Co. Memorial Hospital, Iron Mountain, MI. She was born on March 7, 1918 in Duluth, MN., the daughter of the late Ole and Anna (Barrett) Crosby. She was the salutatorian from Mather High School in Munising in 1936.
