JOSEPH MIKOLYZIK VULCAN- Joseph W. Mikolyzik age 92 of Vulcan died Wednesday, June 14, 2006 at Rivers Edge Adult Care Home in Wallace, Michigan. He was born in Vulcan on March 13, 1914 the son of the late Jacob and Frances (Jacobinski) Mikolajczyk.
