JOSEPHINE JOHNSON HAMILTON LAKES- Josephine M. “Jo” Johnson age 96 of Hamilton Lakes, died Tuesday, May 3, 2011 at Pinecrest Medical Care Facility in Powers, MI. She was born in Milwaukee, WI on November 12, 1914 the daughter of the late William and Alice (Jensen) Hull. Jo graduated from Milwaukee middle school. Jo and her family moved to the Cunard Farm during the Great Depression. She graduated from Hermansville High School in 1932 and married Roy Johnson in 1938; they made their home in Hermansville where Jo joined the First Methodist Church. Roy and Jo moved to Hamilton Lakes in 1966. Jo continued as a member of the First United Methodist Church of Hermansville. It was about this same time that Jo became one of the founding members of the Les Artiste Art Club of Norway. Jo loved to paint and she especially loved the birds.
