KENNETH SIGG QUINNESEC- Kenneth Sigg age 79 of Quinnesec, died Thursday, March 13, 2008 at St. Michael's Hospital in Stevens Point, Wisconsin, following a brief battle with leukemia. He was born July 30, 1928, in Milwaukee, WI, to the late Stephen and Elizabeth Sigg.
