



## Leonard Sandrin

January 20, 1922 - November 18, 2006

LEONARD SANDRIN NORWAY- Leonard D. Sandrin age 84 of Norway died Saturday, November 18, 2006 at Dickinson Co. Memorial Hospital, Iron Mountain, MI. He was born on January 20, 1922 in Vulcan, the son of the late Joseph and Maria (Paoli) Sandrin. Leonard graduated from Vulcan High School in 1940, served his country in the U.S. Marine Corps. during World War II in the South Pacific and China. He married Angeline Lombardo on April 22, 1961 in St. Mary-St. Joseph Church in Iron Mountain. She preceded him in death on August 17, 2000. Leonard worked for Dickinson Co. Memorial Hospital, as an orderly in the Emergency Room for 21 years, he retired in 1980. He was a member of the Norvulet Post #4581, V.F.W. and former President of the Vulcan-Norway-Loretto Lions Club. He loved the St. Louis Cardinals, all the Michigan Teams and enjoyed talking politics. Leonard is survived by his brother Joseph (Luella) Sandrin of Glendale, WI; sister-in-law Katherine Lombardo of Ironwood; several nieces and nephews.
