LEONARD SCHULTZ NORWAY- Leonard J. Schultz age 79 of Norway, died Sunday, October 6, 2013 at Manor Care Health Services in Kingsford, MI. He was born on September 25, 1934 in Hermansville, the son of the late Albert and Vivian (Midle) Schultz. Leonard graduated from Hermansville High School in 1952.
