She worked for Foley-Martens for 14 years running all the machines and the forklifts. She then worked for Grede Foundry until December 2008, first in the mold room, and then worked her way up to the pattern shop. She was the first woman to reach that level. Lori loved gardening, plants and especially her dogs Buster and Max. She loved everyone and everyone loved her in return. Lori is survived by her husband Greg; mother Darlene Orlor; brothers Jim (Jeanne) Richards of Iron Mountain and Alan Richards of Vulcan; sisters Mickey (Russ) Johnson of Iron Mountain and Susie (John) Bergquist of Iron Mountain; her grandfather Virden Hartman and his wife Alice; aunts Bonnie Nelson of Norway and Betty Haferkorn of Aurora, WI; many nieces and nephews; and her best friends Sandy and Tom Niemela.
