LUCILLE ASP CHASKA, MN - Lucille R. Asp age 89, formerly of Norway, passed away Monday, August 25, 2008. She was born in Marquette MI on January 7, 1919, the daughter of the late Otto and Josephine (O'Leary) Ruecker. Lucille graduated from Marquette Graveraet High School and received a Bachelor of Science Degree from Northern Michigan Teachers' College in 1940. She taught Home Economics at the Norway High School and married D.Carrol Asp on December 30,1942 in Marquette. For many years she was a substitute teacher in the local schools and taught Head Start for three years. She was a former leader of Brownie and 4-H groups. Lucille was a member of the Norway-Vulcan Women's Club, the Oak Crest Golf Club, St. Mary's Church and past-president of St. Mary's Altar Society.
