Margaret A. Turner Indian River, MI – Margaret A. Turner age 88 of Indian River, formerly of Hamilton Lakes, died Saturday, August 8, 2009. She was born Margaret Anne Campbell on November 5, 1920 in Columbus, Ohio the daughter of Milton and Emma Grace “Gracie” (Anthony) Campbell. Margaret “Anne” attended school in Elmhurst, Illinois. She went to college there and met Charles M. Turner. The couple was married October 5, 1941 in Elmhurst IL. When Charles returned from the South Pacific after serving as a naval supply officer on the destroyer Nicholas II, he secured a hospital job in the Veteran’s Administration and Anne moved more than a dozen times as Charles advanced in hospital administration. She held a number of temporary administrative assistant positions in the early years, one position for a number of years at Syracuse University, but devoted herself primarily to the care of her husband and three children, Thomas, Lawrence and Marian. Anne and Charlie loved remodeling and living at their retirement home at Lake Mary, which was the most permanent home they ever had. Every morning they went to a different locale for breakfast and took scenic excursions around the area discovering the UP’s beauty. Anne was talented and creative on the piano, designed colorful women’s hats, enjoyed watercolor painting, took up and perfected porcelain doll-making, designing and sewing outfits for each doll, and devoted a large part of her day to the care and layout of her flower gardens which were admired by many.
