LORETTO – Marie Ann Johnson age 92 of Loretto, died Tuesday, April 29, 2025 at Optalis Health and Rehab in Kingsford, MI.

She was born on May 15, 1932 in Norway, the daughter of the late Elmer and Anna (Schafer) Tinti.

Marie graduated from Vulcan High School in 1950.

She married Roland “Buck” Johnson on June 23, 1951 at St. Stephens Church in Loretto. He preceded her in death on September 24, 2002.

Marie worked as a nurse’s aide at the Penn Hospital and Anderson Memorial Hospital in Norway. In 1963, she started working at the 1st National Bank of Norway, until her retirement in 1992 as the executive vice president and secretary of the board of directors of FNB and Interstate Financial Corp.

Marie was a member of St. Barbara’s Church, she was on the Endowment Fund at Holy Spirit School for many years, volunteered at the Dickinson Co. Memorial Hospital and was a former Norway-Vulcan Area Schools Board Member.
