MARJORIE MANDUCA NORWAY- Marjorie Genevieve Manduca, age 93, of Norway, passed away Tuesday, March 29, 2011 at Manor Health Care Services in Kingsford, MI. She was born on December 10, 1917, in Norway, the daughter of the late Henry and Agnes (Beckstrom) Malm. Marjorie met Anthony Manduca in Chicago during World War II. They married on November 18, 1946, in Boston, Massachusetts. She left school in the 12th grade, but returned when she was 51 and graduated from Norway High School in 1968. Marjorie moved to Chicago during World War II and worked for Stewart Warner. At Stewart Warner she was the only woman working in the airplane gauge department. After their marriage, Marjorie and Tony came back to Norway. She was the store manager of Summit Dairy in Norway and Lakeland Dairy in Kingsford. Marjorie liked adventure, and loved to travel the U.S. and Canada with Tony. One of her high points was a 10 day rafting trip down the Colorado River with Tony. She was a lifelong Cubs fan, enjoyed reading, cooking and baking. She won awards for baking at the Dickinson Co. Fair. Marjorie is a member of First Baptist Church in Norway and taught Sunday school. Marjorie is survived by her husband Anthony of 64 years; son Michael (Joan) Manduca of Sturgeon Bay, WI; sisters-in-law Rita Morse of Burlington, MA and Florence Manduca of Salem, NH; many nieces, nephews and cousins.
