VULCAN- Michael P. Maule age 64 of Vulcan, died unexpectedly, Thursday, April 26, 2018 at Dickinson Co. Memorial Hospital in Iron Mountain, MI.

He was born December 24, 1953 in Norway the son of the late George and Sylvia (Luft) Maule.

Mike graduated from North Central High School in 1972 and played football at Ferris State until an injury ended his college career.

Mike was an assistant football and basketball coach at North Central for many years, and was on the coaching staff for the State Championship Team in 1984.

Mike also coached basketball and baseball in Norway, from Little League to High School, there wasn't a kid in the community that didn't get advice or pointers from Mike on how to play baseball. He has been the assistant varsity boy's baseball coach for Norway for the past 8 years.

He was a member of St. Mary's Church in Norway, an avid sports fan, enjoyed hunting and spending time with this family, especially his grandchildren.

Mike worked at Lofholm Lumber since July 1984, as Vice President of

Contractor and Project Sales, and as a estimator and sales person.
