PAUL KARNA NORWAY- Paul Erick Karna age 78 of Norway, died Friday, May 9, 2008 at Dickinson Co. Memorial Hospital, Iron Mountain, MI. He was born March 14, 1930 in Painesdale, MI, son of the late Erick and Ida (Perala) Karna. Paul attended the Painesdale schools. He married Bernice Paquette of Lake Linden on June 20, 1953 in Detroit. She preceded him in death on June 10, 2005. He served his country in the U.S. Army, Head Quarters- HQ Company, 18th Infantry Division during the Korean Conflict from 1953 to 1955 in Germany. Paul worked for 10 years at Precision Springs in Detroit. In 1960 he moved to Norway, MI, where he has resided since. He worked for the Local Plumbers and Pipefitters Union.
