PETER "BOMBER" DEBERNARDI NIAGARA, WI- Peter "Bomber" DeBernardi age 90 of Niagara, died Sunday, December 25, 2005 at his home. Bomber ran the course until 1994, when his son Gerald and Linda took over, but continued to work part time until 2001. He enjoyed entertaining people and spending time with everyone. Bomber is survived by his son Gerald DeBernardi of Niagara; grandson Dante (Brooke Chartier) DeBernardi of Iron Mountain; great granddaughter Sierra Rose Lee; sisters-in-law Irene Opolka of Florida, Alice Stanchina of Escanaba and Esther Cerra of Ste. Saint Marie, Canada; several nieces and nephews; special nephew and friend Ronald DeBernardi; special friends Bruce and Linda Strauss and Gene Carollo.
