April 12, 1933 - June 10, 2025

Norway - Robert "Bob" Joseph Rossato, 92 years old of Norway passed away peacefully on Tuesday June 10, 2025.

Bob was born on April 12, 1933, in Loretto, son of the late Orazio and Theresina (Mauro) Rossato.

Bob grew up in Loretto and graduated from Vulcan High School. After graduation he served his county in the United States Army.
