RONALD HOFFMAN FENCE, WI – Ronald W. Hoffman age 70 of Fence, WI. residing in Norway, died Thursday, May 1, 2008 at Dickinson Co. Memorial Hospital, Iron Mountain, MI. He was born on June 6, 1937 in Algoma, WI., the son of the late Wilmer and Doris (Vaness) Hoffman. Ron graduated from Algoma High School in 1955. He served his country in the U.S. Army directly after high school. Ron married Ann Bohman on September 3, 1960, she preceded him in death on June 24, 1980. He worked for U.S. Plywood Corp. in Algoma, he was a meat cutter at the Piggly Wiggly in Green Bay. Due to love of outdoors he moved his family to Armstrong Creek where he purchased and operated a grocery store from August 1969 to February 1980, and owned and operated an Archway Cookie route. Ron also worked for Northland Associate Grocers of Norway, MI for 8 years, Fleming Inc. of Marshfield, WI. for 5 years and Krist Oil of Iron River, MI for 5 years. He married Susan Bouchey on February 2, 2007 in Iron Mountain. Ron is a member of Bethany Lutheran Church in Norway, where he served on the Church Council. He enjoyed hunting and fishing, was an avid NASCAR fan, he competed in trapshooting for many years throughout Wisconsin, and was a member of the UP Whitetails Association.
