ROY GUILIANI HAMILTON LAKES- Roy James Guiliani age 63 of Hamilton Lakes, died Monday, January 07, 2013 at Dickinson Co. Memorial Hospital in Iron Mountain, MI. He was born on July 22, 1949 in Norway, the son of the late Bernard and Alice (Mish) Guiliani. Roy graduated from Norway High School in 1967 and then Michigan State University in 1971. He married Luanne Addington on August 5, 1972 in Midland, Michigan. Roy worked as a teacher in Prairie Farm, WI and at Holy Spirit School in Norway; he also worked for Sears, AllState Insurance and Home Depot. He was a member of St. Barbara's Church, and enjoyed hunting, bowling, camp, watching the Green Bay Packers and spending time with his family, especially his grandchildren. Roy is survived by his wife of 40 years, Luanne; son Anthony (Alicia) Guiliani of Loretto; daughter Tina (Todd) Coron of Norway; grandsons Austin and Anthony James II Guiliani and Michael and Tyler Coron; brother Robert (Linda) Guiliani of Clare; sisters Joyce (David) Mattson of Cape Coral, FL and Alice Van Eyck of Menominee; brother-in-law Jack (Bill) Addinton of Dubuque, Iowa; sister-in-law Jane (Mark) Priniski of Rib Lake, WI; many nieces and nephews.
