RUBINA DIEDRICH VULCAN- Rubina A. Diedrich age 100 of Vulcan, passed away Saturday, May 19, 2007 at Dickinson Co. Memorial Hospital, Iron Mountain, MI. She was born on December 18, 1906 in Oconto, WI, the daughter of the late Frank and Emily (VanDreese) Boes and moved to Waucedah in 1920 with her parents and sisters. Rubina married Clifford W. Diedrich on June 15, 1925 in Iron Mountain, Michigan. He preceded her in death after 73 years of marriage, on February 23, 1999. She is a member of St. Barbara's Church in Vulcan. Rubina was a long time resident of Dickinson County, living in both Kingsford and Vulcan. She and her husband moved to Cleveland, OH when the Ford Motor Co. closed its Kingsford Plant. They returned to the area in the late 1950's. During their Ohio residency, Rubina worked for the Sherman Williams Paint Company. Rubina was well known as a meticulous housekeeper and an outstanding cook. Rubina is survived by two nieces and two nephews. She was preceded in death by her four sisters Leona Pedo, Claudine McGregor, Orpha LaMuth and Agnes Boes.
