THEODORE STACHOWICZ VULCAN- Theodore "Ted" Stachowicz age 90 of Vulcan, passed away on Wednesday, January 11, 2012 at his home after a brief illness, with his loving wife and family at his side. Ted was born on November 5, 1921 in Vulcan on the Stachowicz Dairy Farm, the son of the late John and Catherine (Forstek) Stachowicz. Ted graduated from Vulcan High School in 1939. He served his country in the U.S. Army during World War II in Italy from 1944-1945. He was a Gunner Specialist, 2nd in command. Ted returned home from the service, where he ran the Stachowicz Dairy Farm, which he was still very active with until his death. He was proud of his farm being a three generation farm operating since 1907. On February 2, 1993 the farm was selected outstanding Conservation Farm of the Year. On February 18, 1950 he was united in marriage to his loving wife Shirley Raiche at St. Barbara's Church in Vulcan, they have been married for 61 years. Ted enjoyed hunting, fishing and going to camp. He also enjoyed spending time with his wife, children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. He is survived by his wife Shirley; three sons William (Kay) Stachowicz, Robert (Sharri) Stachowicz and John (Cathy Rochon) Stachowicz all of Vulcan; three daughters Jane (Butch) Lange of Menominee, Donna (Ralph) Veesser of Powers and Connie (Jim) Grunlund of Vulcan; grandchildren Kristy, Michelle, Jimmy, Nikki, Corissa, Matt, Jake, Ryan, Tyler and Calab; step-grandchildren Nick, Chris, Sarah, Andrew and Melanie; great grandchildren Brent, Zoe, Kaylah, Austin, Kenzie, and Dante; sister-in-law Hazel Stachowicz of

Kingsford; brothers-in-law and sisters-in-law; many nieces and nephews; he also leaves behind his loving dog Buster.
