CLARICE "Dolly" ORLER NORWAY- Clarice "Dolly" Orler age 91 of Norway, died Monday, April 18, 2011 at Freeman Nursing and Rehabilitation Community in Kingsford, MI. She was born on November 7, 1919 in Caspian, the daughter of the late Emil and Lina (Richards) Stanchina. Dolly graduated from Norway High School in 1937.
