VITO BASILE NORWAY - Vito D. Basile age 95 of Norway, died Monday, January 27, 2014 at Maryhill Manor in Niagara, WI. Vito was born on September 15, 1918 in Brooklyn, New York. He served his country in the U.S. Army during World War II. He was a volunteer at the V.A. Medical Center for many years. Vito loved music, cooking, dancing, woodworking, painting and entertaining. His great joy was playing music at the area nursing homes and the V.A. Hospital. Vito continued to entertain at Maryhill until this past October, and then in November, Maryhill became his home. Vito Basile is survived by his only child, Allan Vito Basile and Allan's wife, Linda Basile, of Green Bay, Wisconsin; Grandsons Allan R. Basile and Jeffrey E. Basile; Great Grandsons Jeffery A.
